

Light	Status
Off	If the light is off, Scout is not receiving power. Ensure the power cable is fully inserted and the outlet is working.
Solid White	Scout is powered up and functioning properly.
Flashing White	Scout is booting up after being plugged into power. It is waiting to receive an IP address from the router and should be up and running within minutes.
Flashing Yellow	The flashing yellow light suggests that Scout is not receiving sufficient signal strength from the Evoca tower. The best way to troubleshoot this issue is to move your antenna to another location in your home. You may also wish to use the antenna's booster.
Flashing Orange	Scout is updating and should be back in business in no time.
Flashing Red	A flashing red light means that Scout has encountered a problem. Please call 877-EVOCATV for further instructions on next steps.
Flashing Blue	A flashing blue light means that Scout is in pairing mode and available to connect with a device via Bluetooth.

Flashing Green

A flashing green light means that Scout is thinking about the best way to deliver content to your home — either via the Internet or over-the-air.
